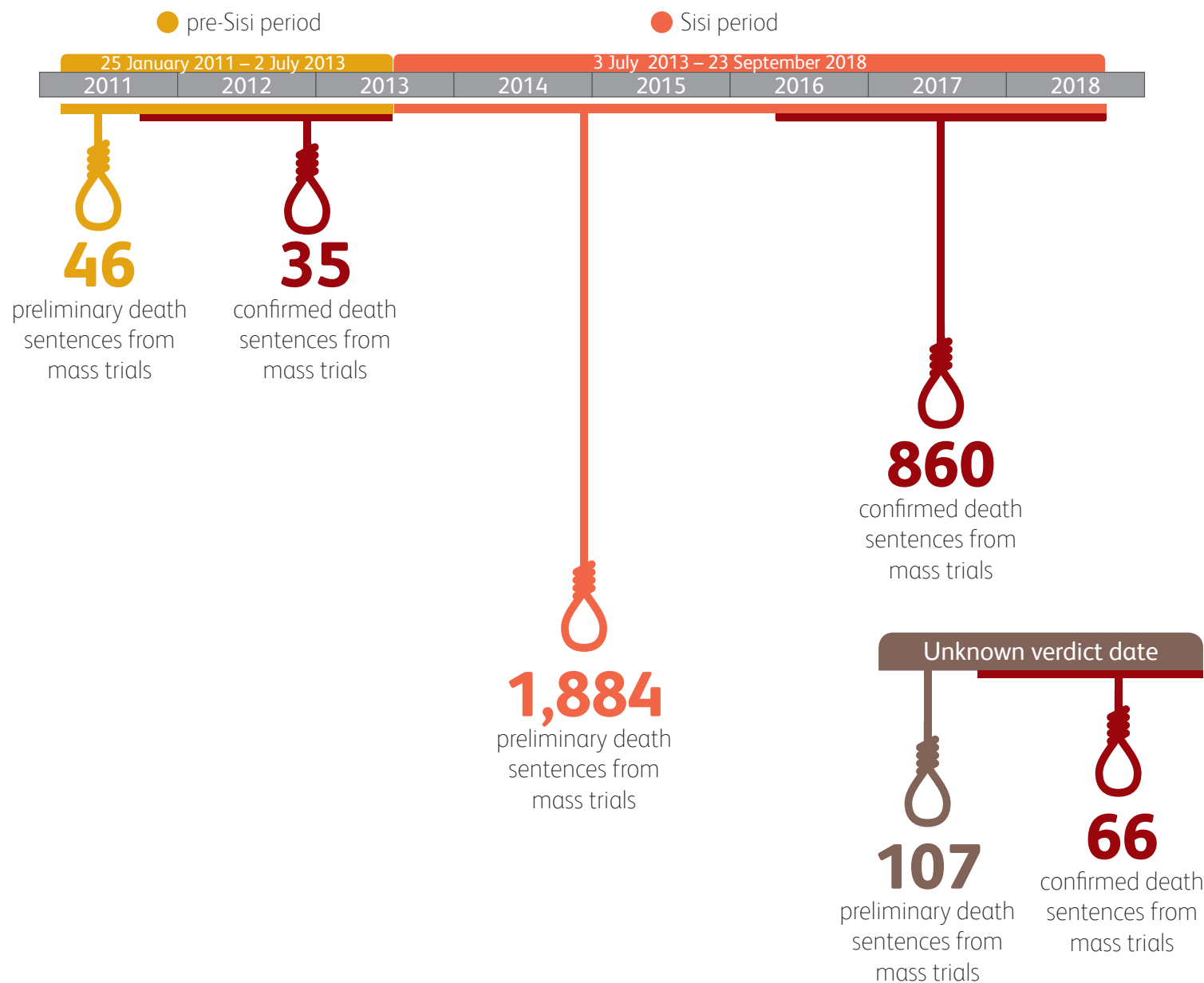
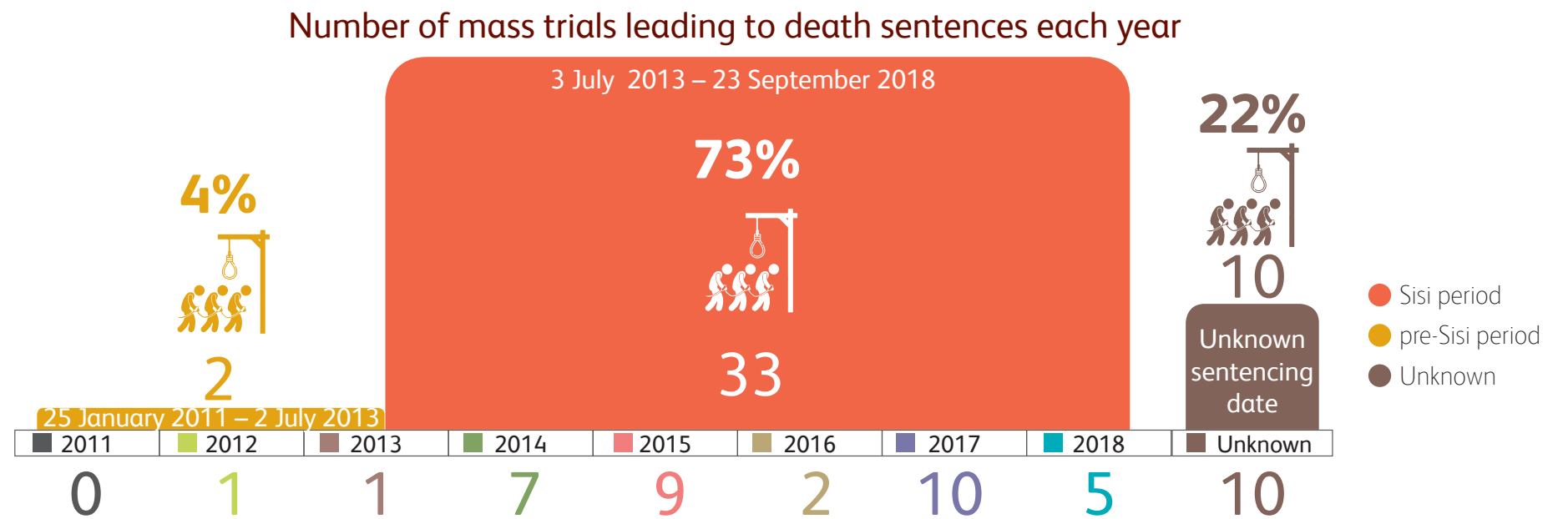
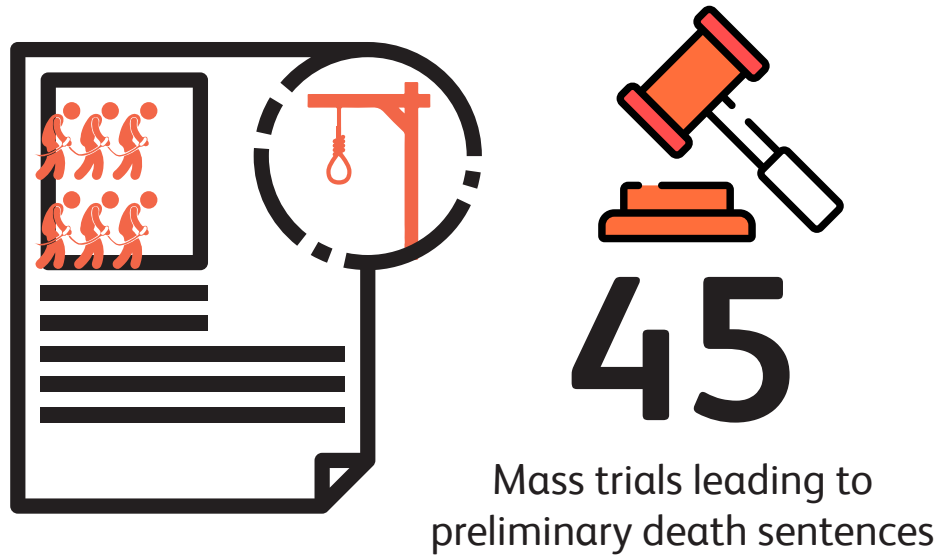


DEATH SENTENCES IN MASS TRIALS

25 JANUARY 2011 - 23 SEPTEMBER 2018



The Index defines a mass trial as one in which 15 or more defendants were tried simultaneously. The Index only tracks mass trials that resulted in death sentences, and does not include information on mass trials that have not yet reached a verdict or mass trials that did not lead to death sentences.

This infographic indicates that between 25 January 2011 and 23 September 2018, 45 separate mass trials resulted in at least one preliminary death sentence. Of these trials, at least 33 (73%) occurred during the Sisi period.

Mass trials led to 2,037 preliminary death sentences (1,884 during the Sisi period) and 961 confirmed death sentences (860 during the Sisi period). This means that 77% of the total 2,443 preliminary death sentences in the Sisi period and 59% of the 1,451 confirmed death sentences in the same period resulted from mass trials.
