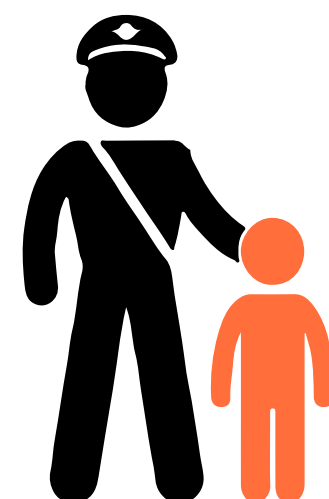


# JUVENILES SENTENCED TO DEATH

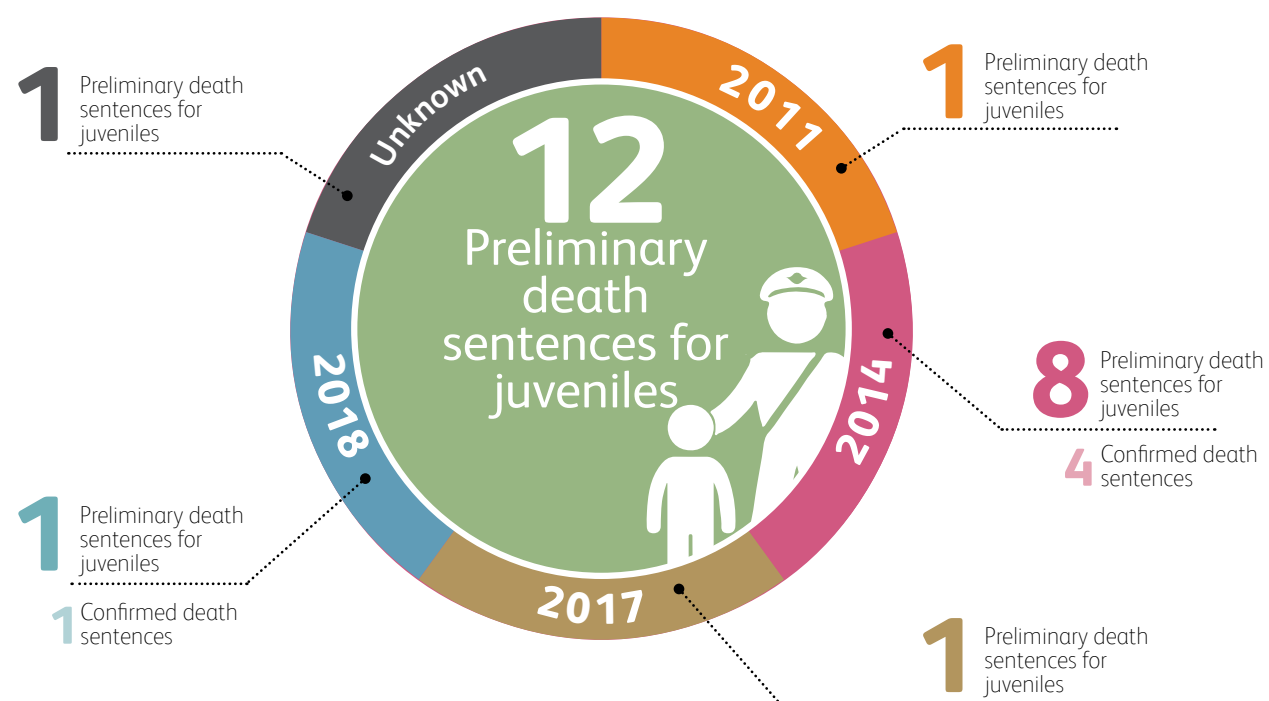
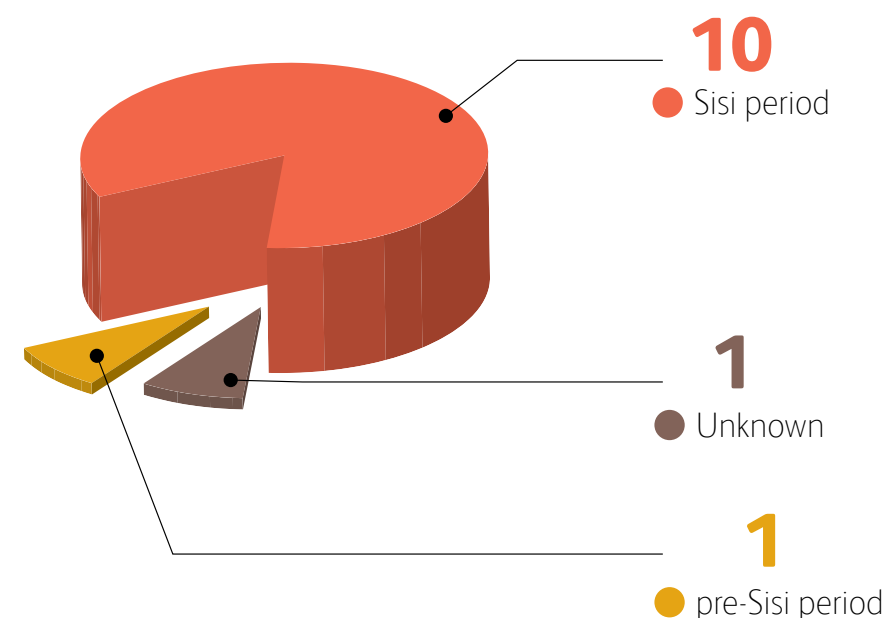

The index identified 12 juveniles who received preliminary death sentences in Egypt; 10 of these 12 sentences occurred during the Sisi period. In 2014, seven juveniles were referred for preliminary death sentences in the course of just two mass trials. One trial, in February 2014, resulted in 528 preliminary death sentences, including for Egyptian juvenile Hatem Zaghloul, whose case was discussed in a Reprivee report published in 2018. Two other juvenile defendants received preliminary death sentences in the same trial. Another trial, in April 2014, led to 683 preliminary death sentences, including for an apparent five juvenile defendants.

Of 12 preliminary death sentences handed to juveniles, five were confirmed. Hatem Zaghloul was one of these people; his death sentence was eventually commuted to a ten-year prison term in 2018. At least one juvenile—Egyptian national Ahmed Saddouma—remains under a sentence of death.
